Everyone get a pen and a blank piece of paper and number 1-25. Pick a group member for each of the following. Finish going through all 25 items before discussing any answers:

- 1. You have to pick one person beside yourself to receive \$10,000 cash. Who do you pick?
- 2. Someone beside you was caught smoking in the bathroom. Who do you first suspect?
- 3. You are allowed to choose one person to successfully complete the program today (beside yourself). Who do you pick?
- 4. If you had to choose who will be the first person to get married in this group, who would you guess?
- 5. Someone stole your car and the rest of the group witnessed it but everyone has a different story. Who would you be inclined to believe the most?
- 6. You have \$1500 cash and you need someone to hold it for the weekend. Who do you trust to do it?
- 7. You desperately need help with a lengthy and difficult research project. Who do you ask for help?
- 8. You have to choose another group member to star in a new reality show and you get 50% of the profit if the show is a success. Who do you pick?
- 9. Who (beside yourself) do you think will be the most successful five years from now?
- 10. An eccentric billionaire offers you one million dollars cash if you can pick someone in this room to make him laugh in less than one minute. Who do you pick?
- 11. This same strange billionaire offers to give you one million dollars two years from now if you can pick someone in this room who can stay out of any trouble at all for the next two years. Who do you pick (besides yourself?)
- 12. Who in this room would you pick to be the poster child for this program?
- 13. You have to share an apartment with one person in this room for one year. Who do you select?
- 14. Someone is waiting outside for you who wants to beat you up. You can take one person here outside with you when you leave. Who?
- 15. You have a deep dark secret and you have to tell someone in this group other than the counselor(s). Who?
- 16. If you had to take over someone's life in this room, who would you pick?
- 17. You hear a rumor that someone in group got locked up, who do you first suspect?
- 18. Who in this room do you think would make the best counselor in the future?
- 19. You are going on a group skydiving trip and you need another group member to pack your parachute. Who?
- 20. Suppose you had to pick someone here to take custody of your baby for one year. Who would you select?
- 21. Everyone in this group needs a kidney transplant or they will probably die. Who do you give yours too?
- 22. You find out you are dying and you have to leave all of your stuff to another group member. Who do you pick?
- 23. Evidence suggests one person here falsified their drug test results. Who is the first person you think of?
- 24. If you had to guess who in this room will stay clean the longest, who would you say?
- 25. If there were no counselors, who would you choose to lead the group for the next month (besides yourself?)

Process – Go through each item and discuss people's answers. Take note of situations when one person's name comes up for a majority of the answers for a particular question. Everyone should keep track of the times when they were the majority answer for a particular question by circling the number of that question.

Did your name come up as the most popular answer for any of the questions? If so how do you feel about it? (Counselor should be careful if someone is potentially upset by the groups answers)
